

MINISTRY CONTEXT

- Alaska is big! It is so big, that every man, woman and child in America could have one acre of land and there would still be 800,000 acres of wilderness remaining.
- A large number of the state's population of 660,000 is made up of people living in rural villages which can only be accessed by plane, boat, or snowmachine.

THE CHALLENGE

- Alaska Native youth have the highest rates of suicide, teen pregnancy and sexual abuse in the country.
- The United Nations considers the death by violent accident rate equivalent to a war zone.
- Because of Alaska's remote geographical location, the struggles of Alaska Native people groups are not on the national radar.

OUR RESPONSE

- In 1992, Covenant Youth of Alaska was formed in response to this crisis through the Evangelical Covenant Church of Alaska.
- Today CYAK works in collaboration with churches and ministries for the cause of ministry to young people in Alaska.

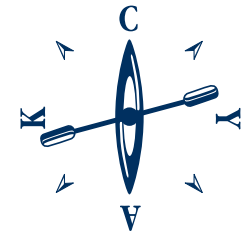
