Discipleship By Creating Together

Wood Shop in Scammon Bay fosters vibrant community

"I remember the deeper

moments and I know

that God is working."

In August 2014 Drew and Holly Williams moved to the village of Scammon Bay in Western Alaska. They were welcomed into the vibrant community where Drew works as the local youth pastor and Holly works as a junior high and high school teacher. Drew also volunteers as the librarian at the Scammon Bay School.

During Drew's time in Scammon Bay, he established the Subsist Wood Shop. This shop was a continuation of his partnership with the community in discipling the

next generation in Scammon Bay through hunting, camping, and

creating. The shop provides space for encouraging tangible skills outside of school and sports, empowering youth to fundraise for events, and strengthening cultural knowledge. Drew walks alongside youth teaching them to make uluaqs, rings and other traditional items.

"It is really awesome to see how kids connect here," Drew reflects. "There is a hunger for culture and for things that belong uniquely to our students. Incredible things happen when youth see that connecting to their culture is both viable in the modern world and connected to the work that God is doing."

Feeling deeply connected to a sense of home creates a foundation on which students can find identity. In the shop, Drew disciples youth in the way of Christ, rooting them both in community and place. This grounding allows

connectedness outside of the shop context after youth have graduated and moved away.

Drew continues, "I will run into kids in Anchorage or at various airports and there is always a hearty hug and a deep gladness that feels like home. Students will sometimes call me when things happen in their life, sometimes positive and sometimes tragic, but it's always an opportunity to pray with them and to connect. It can be hard in the moment at youth group to feel like you are making an impact. Things go wrong
