

Frequently Asked Questions

Is the house for men or women?

We are excited to offer both a men’s and women’s Aarigaa House!

Located next door to each other, this provides great opportunity for expanded community.

Is the AH for UAA students only?

No. While many of our residents have been students at UAA, we also have had working young adults join in the community. Our residents are generally between the ages of 18-24.

How many people live in the AH?

Both the men’s and women’s houses hold four young adults and an RA with the expectation that residents will share a room.

Where is the house located?

The Aarigaa House is located just a safe, 10 minute walk from the edge of campus in the College Gate neighborhood. This provides close proximity to campus, while also being far enough away to not feel like on-campus dorms/housing.
