Covenant Bible Camp and CYAK celebrate official merger made final at the start of the new year.

Covenant Bible Camp is a special place. This truth is known by anyone who has experienced or heard stories of the way God has worked there. Through

the years, Bible Camp has had the blessing of strong and heart-felt leadership guiding the ministry forward. In its most recent season. Nick Bruckner served as the

Executive Director of camp, and he along with others in leadership ensured that camp lived up to its reputation of being a safe place where kids from across Alaska could experience the deep and powerful love of Christ. As Nick expressed, 'With an amazing team, I have seen the Lord change hundreds of lives and build His Kingdom through work on the banks of the North River.' For this, we give God the glory.

With the desire to continue to reach as many kids for Christ as possible, the Bible Camp board met several times over the past year and prayerfully considered how to continue to best steward camp into the future. It became clear that the ministry had grown to a point where having one part-time Executive Director was not sufficient. In weighing different

options, it was decided that a merger with Covenant Youth of Alaska was the best way forward for the ministry. CYAK shares a common mission and heart and is crucial to camp's success each year. This knowledge provided the board confidence in seeing a smooth transition take place.

As of January this year, Covenant Youth of Alaska and Covenant Bible Camp are legally merged under the Alaska Conference of the Evangelical Covenant Church. From a camper's perspective, camp will remain the same. The transitions that will take place are primarily behind the scenes. The responsibilities of the Executive Director will be shared amongst the CYAK staff. CYAK's Associate Director of Operations, Adam London, will serve as the Administrative Director for camp and coordinate the efforts of the CYAK staff who will spearhead fundraising/grant writing/development, volunteer and camper recruitment, programming, and web content/communications. We are thankful that Nick Bruckner will continue to serve in full-time ministry on CYAK Staff in the Norton Sound.
