Discipling Youth Across Alaska

It takes a consistent network to reach youth year-round

Is there someone you can think of who was a formational source of steady encouragement in your faith - especially in

its early days? Maybe it's not a specific mentor that comes to mind, but a youth group, a college Bible Study, or even a positive group of Christian friends that shared the ups and downs of real life together

in your formative years. These experiences stick out in our minds because they are formational. They make an impact. What is the thread of truth that runs through each of these experiences in addition to their focus on Christ? Consistency. Steadiness. Steadfastness.

In CYAK's ministry, we have a model we use to highlight this concept and it's importance - the Continuum of Discipleship Care. This continuum is designed to engage with youth and young adults on their faith journey and provide consistent opportunities to learn and grow in Christ as they develop into adults. It is our vision to see vibrant and healthy communities reflecting the gospel of Christ and led by people God has transformed.

How do we get there? Through coming

alongside Alaska youth and young adults consistently throughout their early years in Christ-centered ministry, discipleship and leadership, so that they will lead the Alaska Church for generations to come.

We know the importance of events like Bible Camp, CHIC, and regional youth retreats. These experiences help youth and young adults meet Christ and recognize the deep love he has for them. These events are a part of the Continuum of Discipleship Care, and they play an important role.

We also know that kids go home after an event and need continued connection to the church as a whole to foster growth in their faith. It is because of this truth that we work to see youth leaders in communities across the state leading weekly Bible Studies, study nights, weekend camping trips, youth groups, ice fishing excursions and more.
