

- Leaders 4 Life High School Conference March 4–6, 2011 in Marshall.


Story of Encouragement:

Special Ministry Update from the Executive Director

Dear CYAK friends and supporters,

As you can see, we've included a special update to let you know that Sue and I will be moving to Unalakleet to set up a CYAK ministry base in the western Alaska!

CYAK is entering a new phase of ministry. Our board has unanimously aggreed that setting up a new regional base of operation in the village of Unalakleet for western Alaska will be a very strategic move. This base of operation will allow us closer accessibilty to our village churches and will allow for more encouragement, coaching, and training in the villages. It will also allow us an opportunity to set up a ministry training center that would allow young adults practical hands on ministry and mentoring experience.

We are excited about ministry in Alaska-2011!! We are so thankful for your partnership and recognize we are only able to minister here because of the help you and others in the body of Christ have offered, so I want to say a huge thank you!

We are just in the beginning of this mobilization and set up, so we need your help. Please consider a special gift in addition to your regular missional giving to Covenant Youth of Alaska. Below you will find a list of some of our current needs as we make this move a reality
